

COMMUNITY & CULTURE BUILDING

For the 2023 – 2024 school year, PVA plans to create a "Community & Culture Building Committee" that has the following goals:

- Create social opportunities for students
- Improve communication and socialization among parents
- Engage more parents in volunteering and fundraising activities

PVA plans to accomplish these goals by:

- Coordinating parents to plan quarterly events for each grade level outside of school hours
- Organizing events for parents and Pine View Alumni to come together and socialize


Pinnacle – our largest fundraiser of the year and is an annual dinner gala and auction event.
