The PVA strives to enhance and enrich Pine View students' school experience by supporting the school's academic, social, fine arts and technology objectives. The PVA encourages volunteerism, raises and disburses funds, promotes communication and cooperation with the school, provides input to the school on issues of concern to parents and supports gifted advocacy issues on a local and statewide basis.



The Three Ws of PVA Funding Requests

Who?

Funds may be requested of PVA by administrators, guidance staff, teachers, club sponsors or board members.

Students and parents must have a faculty/staff sponsor in order to present a funding request.

When?

Requests must be approved by Dr. Covert and passed on to PVA two weeks prior to the second Tuesday of each month, excluding June, July, August and December.

For requests >\$500, requestors attend a PVA board meeting to present their proposal and answer any questions.

Any funding request that is submitted within two weeks of the PVA meeting will be held for voting until the following month. Requests are typically not reviewed in December or January



- Dr. Covert will also submit to the PVA President and the Funding Request Chair (Puja Dhanraj and Gretchen Lovewell)
- If approved, the request is forwarded to the entire PVA Board
- Or, Dr. Covert might send it back to you for additional information

Next Steps

- Gretchen works with PVA to gather any questions or concerns from board members
- Questions/concerns are forwarded to the requestor so that we can work together to address any issues or concerns prior to the PVA Board Meeting

Next Steps

Funding Requests ≤\$1,000

- Requestor may present to PVA Board, but it is not required
- Requestor prepares a written proposal that will be reviewed and voted on during PVA Board Meeting

Funding Requests >\$1,000

- Requestor gives a 3-minute presentation at PVA Board Meeting
- PVA Board Meeting includes funding request vote (with limited discussion because we've already worked out the kinks prior to the meeting!)

What PVA considers when voting...

- How does funding further Pine View School and PVA's missions?
- Does the funding request benefit an underserved group at PV?
- Does funding raise Pine View's overall profile?
- How has the club raised funds in the past?

- Does it directly or indirectly benefit a significant number of students?
- How do we view a club, group or classroom asking for one monetary amount to be used for the entire year's expenses at will?
- Are the objectives/outcomes obtainable?
- How will the club or organization view its responsibility to PVA in reporting its impact?

Next Steps, after award

- Successful requests and presentations provided to PVA for repository
- Once funds are spent, prepare a final report to PVA with the following:
 - Total budget, PVA funding amount, additional sources of funding, uses of funds
 - Project objectives and goals
 - Details of project accomplishments and their significance
 - Description of need or any plans for additional work on this project
 - Any explanation of changes to the goals and objectives
 - Explanation of how the project results have been or will be disseminated
